



GALAPAGOS ISLANDS OVERVIEW

- Volcanic archipelago in the Pacific Ocean
- Province of Ecuador, 1,000km west of its coast
- Populated by ca. 25.000 inhabitants
- One of the world's foremost destinations for wildlife viewing
- 13 main islands
- 6 smaller islands
- 107 rocks and islets
- Complete area of 7880km2
- Isolated terrain with diversity of unique plant and animal species
- Charles Darwin visited in 1835, inspiring his theory of evolution



SCIENCE & HISTORY

- Formed by subsea eruptions, pushing up a group of volcanic islands
- Colonised by rainforest animals from central & South America, floating across on rafts of vegetation
- Species were compelled to adapt
- Sometimes called a "Living Laboratory"
- "On The Origin of Species"



WHEN TO GO

December - May (Hot Season)


- Tropical conditions
- Seas are generally calm
- Occasional showers
- Green and lush
- Hot and humid (26 °C to 30 °C)
- Water temperature averages 26 °C
- Underwater visibility very good (20-25 meters) Proper tropical environment for

June to November (Dry Season)

swimmers and snorkelers

- Sea temperatures 20 °C 23 °C
- Air temperatures 23 °C 26 °C
- Hardly any rain (one of the driest places in the tropics)
- Stronger winds (wind-chill factor)
- Sea can be more wavy
- advise to use a wet suit during this season for snorkeling








